* Teams will wait outdoors or in vehicles, be prepared for cold weather

* Please bring everything you will need with you for the day, suggestions include:

- A mask if desired
- meals and refreshments for yourself
- treats (avoid small and/or crumbly treats, you may incur faults for dropping treats in the search area)
- food, water and poop bags for your dog
- harness and long-line
- weather appropriate clothing for you and your dog

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Dogs must be UKC registered: have a UKC Registration Number; or a Performance Listing (PL)/ Limited Privilege (LP); or Temporary Listing (TL) number in order to participate. Visit <https://www.ukcdogs.com/register-my-dog> for more information.

There shall be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of reason for such dismissal. A dog or handler who suffers an injury and/or illness or bitches that come into season after the closing date may be eligible for a refund of their total entry fee.

Know the Rules: Competitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they understand the UKC Nosework rules and regulations (found here: <https://www.ukcdogs.com/nosework>) including but not limited to the following rules regarding entry:

- All competitors are expected to treat your canine partner, trial hosts, the judges, and all other competitors and spectators with respect.
- Good sportsmanship is expected of all competitors, volunteers, hosts and judges.
- Safety for both dogs and people is of foremost consideration in actions and conduct by handlers and their dogs at all times.
- Handlers, through entry at this event, accept full responsibility for themselves and the actions of their dogs.
- Competitors, volunteers, judges and spectators shall not discuss hide placement, details of a search area, or a dog or handler's performance during the search until after the trial has completed.
- Videos or photos may NOT be shared in any way until AFTER the trial is finished.
- Any exhibitor whose dog creates unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engages in unsafe or disruptive behavior will be asked to leave the show site.
- Exhibitors and dog owners are expected and required to clean up after their own dogs.
- There will be no indoor crating for this event. Dogs must be crated in their cars. The only exception is when the dog is being pottied or proceeding to a search area.
- While being walked on the grounds, dogs must be kept on a leash no longer than 6 feet in length. Longer lines and flexi leashes may be used only during a search. Handlers will be given time to change leashes if needed before the search. Dogs should be kept a reasonable distance (10 feet) apart. Some dogs may require additional space.
- Bitches in season, pregnant or lactating females may not compete. Ill dogs, dogs having sutures, bandages or anything indicative of a medical procedure, or dogs obviously in pain will be excused at the judge's discretion.
- The Whitehorse Woofers Dog Club, UKC, the grounds owners, the judge, their agents, and their club members assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injuries sustained by spectators or exhibitors, to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children not under the control of their parents or guardians.
